Fourth Judicial District Court Domestic Violence Deferred Sentence Instructions

- o **Immediately** pay your court cost and fines at 20 E. Vermijo, Room **105**. If you do not have financial resources at this time, make payment arrangements in Room **116**.
- Within 10 days of your guilty plea you will need to obtain your discovery paperwork from the District Attorney's Office at 105 E.
 Vermijo, 6th floor. Bring \$4.00 cash (you will need this paperwork to enroll in treatment).
- You have been ordered to enroll in domestic violence treatment within 10 days of your release. You must <u>fax or mail</u> your proof of enrollment to the Domestic Violence Case Monitor or have your treatment provider fax proof of enrollment for you.
- O You are required to attend your domestic violence treatment consistently until completed. Absences <u>must</u> be pre-approved by your treatment provider. **Three absences maximum**.
- o You must notify the Domestic Violence Case Monitor of any status changes, including: address, phone number, any new criminal charges or any concerns with your domestic violence treatment.

Failure to comply with these instructions is a violation of your court order and can result in revocation of your deferred sentence.
